

**MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION
MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS PURSUANT TO
OCGA 48-5-311(B):**

- 18 years of age or older
- Have resided in Pike County for six months
- The most experienced, upright and intelligent person
- Not the holder of any elected office in the state or local government or held such office within a period of two years preceding the appointment.
- Not a convicted felon who has not been pardoned or had his or her civil rights restored.
- Own real property in Pike Co.
- Not a member of the governing authority of a county municipality or consolidated government, member of a county board of assessors, employee of the county board of tax assessors or county tax appraiser.
- This position requires an off-site (40) hour course after appointment by the Grand Jury (furnished by the state) and an eight (8) hour annual (on-line) continuing education course.
