

⚠️ SCAM ALERT!! BE EDUCATED! ⚠️

It has been brought to our attention citizens of Pike Co. have received phone calls indicating missed jury duty. Superior Court clerks will only call to inform you of your time to be available or to let you know if a jury call has been cancelled. We will not call if you missed duty.

Jury duty scams in Georgia involve phone calls claiming that a victim has missed jury duty and must pay a fine to avoid arrest. The scammers may impersonate court officials or law enforcement.

How to avoid jury duty scams:

- Don't provide any personal or financial information to unknown callers.
- Don't pay any money or purchase prepaid cards.
- Document phone number & report the incident to your local law enforcement agency.

How scammers operate:

- Scammers may use real names of court officials, law enforcement officers, and federal judges.
- They may also use real court addresses.
- Scammers may "spoof" the phone number to appear to be from a court or government agency.
- They may ask for personal information like Social Security numbers, credit card numbers, or date of birth.
- They may threaten arrest or jail time.
